



Photography/Video/Social Media Policy for The Orpheus Club of Philadelphia

We appreciate that many of our members and guests may wish to record and/or photograph various Orpheus-related events. We also recognize that social media, such as Facebook, enables the Orpheus Club to promote its mission and to connect with our Associate Members and potential members. At the same time, the inappropriate sharing of Orpheus-related recordings and photographs through social media is a growing concern. We must balance privacy, security, and intellectual property concerns against the desire to capture and share Orpheus memories.

After review by our Executive Committee, we have created the following policies about recording our private concerts and events at our clubhouse. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation, and we look forward to celebrating another great season with you!

Private Concerts

At our private concerts, the use of video recording devices is prohibited. The taking of non-flash photographs is permitted. These photographs may be shared on social media (including but not limited to, Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, etc.). Please feel free to “tag” the Orpheus Facebook page with your posts from our concerts ([@orpheusclub](#) / Friends of The Orpheus Club of Philadelphia).

Clubhouse Events

During Revels performances, the taking of photographs and use of video recording devices is strictly prohibited. During other events in the Orpheus clubhouse, photographs and videos may be taken for personal use. However, the posting or sharing of any images or videos from inside the Clubhouse on social media is prohibited. Any images or videos found to be in violation of this policy will be reported, and a request will be filed to remove the item.

Violation of these policies may result in the suspension or revocation of membership privileges.
