### **Dear Orpheus Club Members:**

Please find the enclosed tickets for our exciting 2018 Mid-Winter concert. The theme this year is “On the Sunny Side of Van Pelt Street”. You will see two dates on the enclosed tickets. Each ticket may be used (once) for either concert night. (You may split use of your four tickets across both nights.) If you attended our concert last year at the Union League of Philadelphia, you know what a beautiful intimate venue this was for us and with this system we have a nice balance of audience across both nights. Due to a generous offer from the Union League for two nights there, (and the willingness of our Singing Members to give two concerts) we are again going to perform the same concert on back to back nights in Lincoln Hall, on Wednesday, February 28th and Thursday, March 1st. By going to the Club’s web site you can let us know approximately how many to expect on each night. You will not receive a reply or confirmation, except in the event of a pending capacity issue on one night or the other. The Club will send a follow up email to all members for whom we have email addresses, indicating “sold out” for that night, and for any so far not reserved to that point (which information will also be posted on the Club’s web site). We want to avoid a capacity issue and the need for standing on either night.

Plan to come early for a cash bar and complimentary hors d’oeuvres! The Union League will offer these in and around Lincoln Hall from 7:45 until 8:20 p.m. The same will apply at Intermission. We also encourage your use of nearby parking garages other than the one the Union League owns on Sansom Street, since the exodus of all patrons at once causes a large bottleneck for a single garage and its staff, and thus a considerable wait time. We will also have an unmanned coat check option upstairs, near Lincoln Hall. This is an all-Orpheus concert. The Club will be conducted by our talented and inspiring conductor, John Shankweiler, and accompanied by our amazing accompanist, Mark Daugherty on piano. Make plans now to attend!
